Stanton Energy Reliability Center's Annual College Scholarship Program for Stanton Area High Schools

High School Seniors Eligible for \$2,000 in Awards

In 2016, to show its appreciation of the Stanton community, Stanton Energy Reliability Center, a community energy reliability center, instituted an annual college scholarship program to benefit Stanton community high school students. The program awards \$2,000 in scholarships. We are currently accepting scholarship applications from students in the class of 2019.

Stanton Energy Reliability Center will award scholarships to college-bound seniors from the following public high schools:

- Magnolia High School - \$1,000
- Rancho Alamitos High School - \$1,000

A committee in Stanton Energy Reliability Center's headquarters in Sacramento, California will select the scholarship recipients. We are looking for students who:

- Are majoring in engineering or technology with an interest in the energy or power industry
- Exhibit personal or community leadership
- Demonstrate financial need
- Plan to enroll in full-time undergraduate study at an accredited two-year or four-year college, university or vocational-technical school for the entire 2019-2020 academic year

Stanton Energy Reliability Center is a state-of-the art community energy reliability center designed to deliver superior reliability services with a minimal carbon footprint and low emissions profile that will supply energy reliability to the community under a 20-year resource adequacy purchase agreement with Southern California Edison (SCE).
